Title	What makes a Scientist?
Subtitle	
Target group	1st Level School Children (6 to 8 year olds)
Objective(s)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To discuss what a scientist is</li> <li>• To discuss the diversity in the sciences and the jobs that exist</li> <li>• To discuss who can be a scientist and why</li> <li>• To begin approaching what a stereotype is</li> <li>• To allow pupils to question their own ideas</li> </ul>
Summary	This lesson uses a series of activities and discussions to introduce the idea of stereotypes surrounding STEM careers. This includes discussion about what makes a scientist and the diversity in the sciences themselves.
